BINDING FABRIC

Fabric **L** PWK68805 (*Included*)

- Fabrics **A, E, F, G** and **H** are directional fabrics so please follow the diagram below on how to cut your pieces.

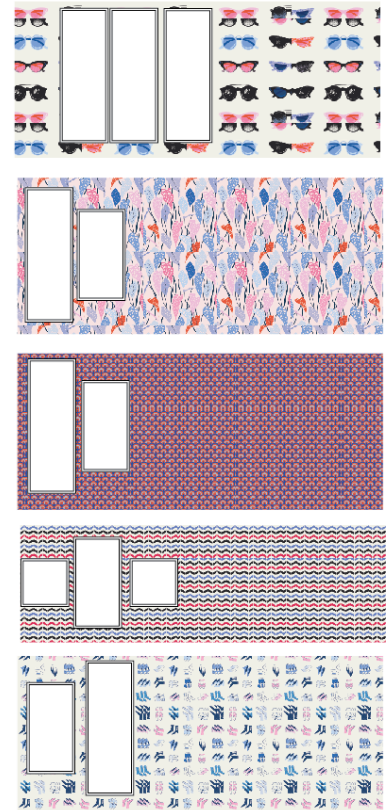


DIAGRAM 1

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

*¼" seam allowances are included.
WOF means width of fabric.*

- Three (3) 5½" x 15½" rectangles from fabric **A**.
- One (1) 10½" x 5½" rectangle from fabric **B**.
- One (1) 5½" square from fabric **B**.
- Two (2) 10½" x 5½" rectangles from fabric **C**.
- Two (2) 5½" x 15½" rectangles from fabric **D**.
- One (1) 5½" x 15½" rectangle from fabric **E**.
- One (1) 5½" x 10½" rectangle from fabric **E**.
- One (1) 5½" x 10½" rectangle from fabric **F**.
- One (1) 5½" x 15½" rectangle from fabric **F**.
- One (1) 5½" x 10½" rectangle from fabric **G**.
- One (2) 5½" square from fabric **G**.
- One (1) 5½" x 10½" rectangle from fabric **H**.
- One (1) 5½" x 15½" rectangle from fabric **H**.

- Twenty eight (28) 5½" x 1½" strips from fabric **I**.
- Twelve (12) 24¾" x 1½" strips from fabric **I**.
- Three (3) 5½" squares from fabric **J**.
- Two (2) 5½" squares from fabric **K**.
- Three (3) 10½" x 5½" rectangles from fabric **L**.
- Five (5) 1½" x WOF strips from fabric **L**.
- Three (3) 10½" x 5½" rectangles from fabric **M**.
- One (1) 5½" square from fabric **M**.
- Four (4) 5½" squares from fabric **N**.

CONSTRUCTION

Sew all rights sides together with ¼" seam allowance.

- Arrange fabrics **A-N** into seven (7) columns.
- For fabric placement and attachment see diagram 1.
- Press your seams open.

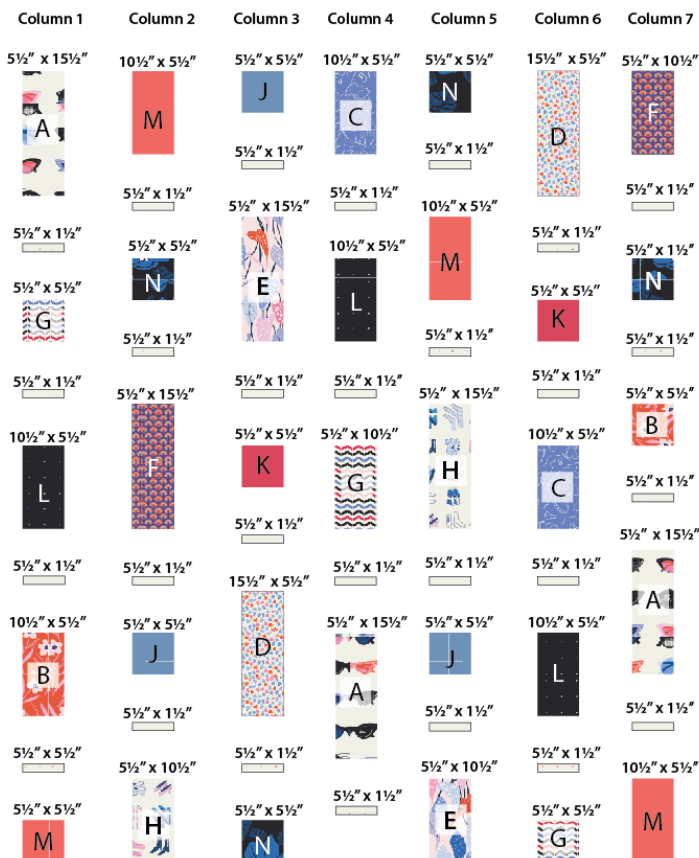


DIAGRAM 2

- Join two (2) 24¾" x 1½" strips from fabric **I**.
- Repeat this step five (5) more times. You should have six (6) 49½" x 1½" strips from fabric **I** in total.
- Place one (1) 49½" x 1½" strip in between each column.

- Sew each strip.
